Dear 500 enthusiasts,

With just less than 3 months to go until the 2011 TT/XT 500 Muster, the plans for the event are well under way. The dates being 29th and 30th of October with 2 different rides planned for Saturday, a dinner Saturday night and the show'n'display day on Sunday.

The 1st ride is the road ride leaving from the Bethany Reserve at 10.30am, to get away on time, please be there by 10am with your tanks full as the first planned fuel stop is a way into the ride. The ride is on sealed roads and will take in some of the Barossa on a ride through the Adelaide Hills or on the ride to the Riverland. A lunch stop will happen somewhere along the way before returning back to the Bethany Reserve around 4pm. The ride length could be up to 240kms and will be a good ride.

The second ride is a paddock (track) ride being held in co-junction with the Keyneton MCC club day at a property on Mengler Hill just 10 minutes from Bethany Reserve. The day will consist of ride sessions of 20 minutes with the different classes that are there on the day. Usually each class gets 4-5 rides in depending on the numbers on the day but go to the club web site www.keynetonmcc.asn.au for the entry info and details of the day. They are usually up 2-3 weeks before the day of event and you can enter on line. Just need to add that you are with the Muster to waive the club membership as you will be part of the Muster group. This will finish around 3.30 – 4pm so as there is time to pack up and clean up for the evening meal.

The evening meal is planned to be at the Tanunda Club on the corner of Basedow Rd and MacDonald St. Meet at 6.30 for a 7pm start. There is a good selection of food at a good price for everyone to enjoy. For booking the tables, please let Kevin know how many will be attending prior the weekend as the venue books out very quickly and only a few extra seats can be made available on the night. Sunday, at the Bethany Reserve, is the big display day where we hope to get 100 plus bikes on display to help celebrate the 10th running of the TT/XT 500 Muster. The show will start from 10am and conclude after the awards and prizes have been given, so be in it to win it. We will be running our popular, monster raffle as well as a silent auction that we ran last year for the first time. There will more trophies this year as we increase the categories to include the best bike from each year group. The judging for the trophies will happen from around 1pm with the presentation to take place at 2pm followed by the monster raffle draw. The silent auction winners will be announced around the same time so that those who have travelled along way can get going soon after if they wish. Once again, the catering will be run by the Angaston Scouts with great food and soft drinks to keep everyone refreshed. If you wish anything stronger, it is advisable to bring that along with you. There will be a limited number of 2011 hats available along with stubbie coolers, beer steins and stickers, on the day or you can pre-order the hats along with the shirts that are also available.
